Project scope

Wiley delivered the design and construction of a sports court, three classrooms, a music facility, retractable seating, a kiosk, audio-visual system, amenities, two carparks and a new stop, drop and go zone.

Safety first

The school has one access road for students, staff and visitors, posing significant safety challenges for the project delivery team.

Highly experienced in stakeholder engagement and working in a live, operational environment, the Wiley Education team devised an innovative solution that prioritised the safety of all people on site.

Working closely with key stakeholders, Wiley investigated the site and created an alternative temporary entrance to the school through neighbouring streets, utilising an old access point that had overgrown.

By reopening this access point, Wiley maintained the crucial segregation between contractors and the school community, especially during pick up and drop off times.
